Since its first edition, the **International Landscape Biennial** has expressed its desire to intently study and discuss landscape interventions, as much from the perspective of landscape architecture as from other disciplines that are linked to its study and evolution.

The Biennial has been consolidated on a European scale in its seven previous editions : "Remaking Landscapes" (1999), "Gardens in Arms" (2001), "Only with Nature" (2003), "Landscape: a Product / a Production" (2006), "Storm & stress" (2008) , "Liquid Landscape" (2010) and "Biennial versus Biennial" (2012). And also on an international scale in the last edition as we have focused on the contemporary international landscapes thanks to its Rosa Barba landscape prize.

Program

On the **25th, 26th and 27th September 2014**, Barcelona will open itself to landscape in a symposium adapted to contemporary circumstances. During these three days, the calendar will include talks, presentations by those finalists competing for the 8th "Rosa Barba" Landscape Award, papers, roundtable discussions, exhibitions and samples from which we will be able to track and discuss the evolution of landscape design in Europe.

The Biennial is organized by the Association of Architects of Catalonia (COAC) and the Polytechnic University of Catalonia (Master in Landscape Architecture).

One year more Barcelona will host the **International Exposition of University Projects in the Schools of Architecture and Landscape**. The organizing committee considers that the participation of the didactic works remarkably contributes to enrich the debate on landscaping. For this reason, we further encourage the acceptance of our invitation to this call, promoting the most valuable projects of your school.

It is in our best interest to stress the submission of those that you consider the most interesting projects of the **last two years**, that can represent both works of investigation and design of your school.

A selection of these projects will be part of an exhibition, that will be celebrated in the Technical School Superior of Architecture of Barcelona, **from the 26th September till the 11th October 2012**. As well as in the past, the exhibition will be visited by several European universities.

Resolution

The organizing committee of the International Exhibition of University Projects in Schools of Architecture and Landscape, through an international jury, will award the winning school with a **prize to the best project** presented. Moreover, all that works that will be considered remarkable for the treated themes and their solutions will receive a special mention.

All the projects that will be shown in the exhibition are subject to the a selection carried out by the organizing committee.

Set of rules

A maximum of 10 and not less than 3 projects that develop the theme of landscape in a very wide meaning, from ecology to urban public space, will be accepted on behalf of the students of each school.

Documentation to be submitted:

a) Technical dossier:

A4 template sheet with the following information:

- Title of the project (objectives, site)
- Authors (students name)
- Title of the course (subject, study, diploma and grade, workshop, research)
- Academic year
- Teaching staff (Names of professors and tutors)
- Department / Section / Program of belonging
- University / School
- A short description of the project in English, no more than 250 words

b) Graphic documentation:

- Front page: 1 panel, Din A3 landscape format
- 3 panels, Din A3 format, presented horizontally, that include:
 - General plan of situation
 - Plan of location
 - Project: plans, sections, details...
 - Projectual processes: sketches, schemes, notes...
 - Images: aerial photographs, views, renders, photomontages, photos of scale models, collages...

Date and place of delivery

The deadline for the delivery of projects is **May 23th, 2014**
